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Appointment of Contractor for installation of SACP system to mitigate under protection issue under Rajkot Base.

1.1 Technical Criteria

- 1.1.1 One work order for Maintenance (i.e. supply, installation and commissioning of C. P. equipments / instruments) on Impressed Current Cathodic Protection System installed in Hydrocarbon pipelines during last 7 years reckoned from the date of this NIT.
- 1.1.2 Bidder shall have successfully executed at least one or more similar work during last 7 years reckoned from the due date of bid submission, which should be not less than.
 - i) One work order costing not less than INR 30 Lakhs;
 - OR
 - ii) Two work orders costing not less than INR 21 Lakhs each.
- 1.1.3 The bidder must have minimum NACE CP3 - Cathodic Protection Technologist (may be outsourced consultant) having minimum 5 years of experience.
- 1.1.4 Bidder shall have valid ISO: 9001-2015 Quality Management System certification.

1.2 Financial Criteria:

- 1.2.1 Net Worth: Bidder shall have positive net worth as per audited accounts as on 31.03.2025, i.e. FY 2024-25. In case the Bidder is a company, Net Worth shall be Paid up share capital plus Free Reserves & Surplus less accumulated losses, deferred expenditure and miscellaneous expenditure not written off, if any. In case the Bidder is a sole proprietorship firm or a partnership firm, the net worth shall be considered as the sum of the proprietor's capital or partners' capital and reserve and surpluses. In case of sole proprietorship, the net worth shall be based on all of proprietor's business assets and liabilities.

Documents required:

- *Certificate from a Chartered Accountant/ Statutory Auditor of the Company with UDIN, shall also be submitted to this effect.*
- *Audited Annual Reports for last three (3) financial years.*

- 1.2.2 Bidder must have valid GST & PAN.
- 1.3 The Bidder shall not be on holiday list/ black-listed by GSPL or any of the GSPC group company. Bidder shall submit self-declaration certificate in this regard. If declaration found false, the bid shall be rejected and EMD shall be forfeited or Contract shall be terminated without any notice period and PBG & SD (as may be applicable) shall be forfeited.
- 1.4 The Bidder is not put on "Holiday" by Public Sector Project Management Consultant (like EIL, Mecon) or banned/blacklisted by Government department/public Sector Undertaking on due date of submission of bid. Further, neither Bidder nor their allied agency/(ies) are on banning list of the Ministry of

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Petroleum and Natural Gas. In case there is any change in status of the declaration prior to award of contract, the same has to be promptly informed to the Owner by the Bidder. It shall be the sole responsibility of the Bidder to inform about their status regarding "Holiday/Blacklisting" herein above on due date of submission of bid and during the course of finalization of the tender. Concealment of the facts shall tantamount to misrepresentation of facts and shall lead to action against such Bidders as per provision of tender. The Bidder shall be required to furnish an undertaking in respect of the above, duly executed on a non-judicial stamp paper of appropriate value, in a format prescribed, as part of its bid submission. If declaration found false, the bid shall be rejected and EMD shall be forfeited or Contract shall be terminated without any notice period and PBG & SD (as may be applicable) shall be forfeited.

- Bidder to submit self-declaration on stamp paper of minimum Rs.300/- for above requirement.
- 1.5 Bidder shall not be under insolvency, liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings. Bidder shall submit self-declaration certificate in this regard.
- 1.6 Bidders who have initiated legal action/litigation against GSPL or any of the GSPC group company, shall not be considered eligible for bidding. Further, Bidders against whom GSPL or any of the GSPC group company has initiated inquiry/ legal action/ litigation shall not be considered eligible for bidding. Bidder shall submit self-declaration certificate in this regard.
- 1.7 Consortium/ Joint venture bids are not acceptable.

Notes:

- Offers of those bidders who themselves do not meet the technical experience criteria as stipulated in the BQC can also be considered provided the bidder is a subsidiary company of the parent company in which the parent company has 100% stake or parent company can also be considered on the strength of its 100% subsidiary. However, the parent/subsidiary company of the bidder should on its own meet the technical experience criteria as stipulated in the BQC and should not rely for meeting the technical experience criteria on its sister subsidiary/co-subsubsidiary company or through any other arrangement like Technical collaboration agreement. In that case, as the subsidiary company is dependent upon the technical experience of the parent company or vice-versa with a view to ensure commitment and involvement of the parent/ subsidiary company for successful execution of the contract, the participating bidder should enclose an agreement between the parent and the subsidiary company or vice-versa and Parent/Subsidiary Guarantee from the parent/subsidiary company for fulfilling the obligation under the Agreement, along with the techno-commercial bid.
- The failure to meet the above qualifying criteria(s) above shall render the bid to be summarily rejected.

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- Experience of only the bidding entity shall be considered. In-house work experience (where for the past experience referred for qualification, the sub-contractor and the owner belong to the same organization) shall not be considered as valid experience for the purpose of qualification.
 - The documentary proof in the form of work order (including scope of work) & completion certificate from client/ principal agency/ Owner's authorized representative has to be submitted along with the bid.
 - In case, bidder intends to get evaluated based on work done as Sub-Contractor experience basis, bidder shall submit the following documents towards adherence to the criteria specified herein:
 - Purchase Order/ Work Order / Contract issued by Main Contractor; and
 - Sub-Contract Approval granted by End Client; and
 - Satisfactory work completion certificate issued by End Client.
