Technical Criteria:	
1. Experience Criteria:	
1.1 The bidder shall have supplied & installed minimum 02 nos. of Automatic Voltage Regulator (AVRs) or Servo Control Voltage Stabilizer (SCVS) of rating 80 kVA or above during the last 07 (seven) years reckoned from the date of NIT.	Copy of POWO for above criteria to be submitted along with bid.
1.2 Bidder shall be OEM for AVR/SCVS.	Documentary Proof for Valid Manufacturer i.e ISO / Industrial manufacturing certificate.
1.3 Bidder shall have valid ISO: 9001-2015 Quality Management System certification.	Bidder to submit valid ISO certificate.
2. Financial Criteria:	
2.1 Net worth:	
Bidder shall have positive net worth as per audited accounts as on 31.03.2025 . In case the Bidder is a company, Net Worth shall be Paid up share capital plus Free Reserves & Surplus less accumulated losses, deferred expenditure and miscellaneous expenditure not written off, if any. In case the Bidder is a sole proprietorship firm or a partnership firm, the net worth shall be considered as the sum of the proprietor's capital or partners' capital and reserve and surpluses. In case of sole proprietorship, the net worth shall be based on all of proprietor's business assets and liabilities.	Certificate from a Chartered Accountant with UDIN No. and Annual Reports (refer Format provided under "Forms & Procedures").
2.2 Turn Over:	
The Bidder shall have minimum annual turnover of INR 60 Lakhs in any of the last three (3) financial years (FY 2024-25, 2023-24, 2022-23) from the date of Notice Inviting Tender (NIT).	Bidder has to submit Annual Reports [Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account Statement] in this regards.
3 Registration Criteria	
3.1 PAN Registration	
Bidder shall have a valid PAN Card.	A copy of PAN card .
3.2 Tax Registration Certificate	
Bidder shall have a valid GST Registration Certificate.	A copy of GST Registration Certificate .
4 Other Criteria	

The Bidder shall not be on holiday list/ black-listed by GTL or any of the GTL group company.	Bidder shall submit self-declaration certificate in this regard. If found, the bid shall be rejected and EMD shall be forfeited or Contract shall be terminated without any notice period and PBG & SD (as may be applicable) shall be forfeited.
The Bidder shall not be under winding up, insolvency resolution process, liquidation, court receivership or other similar legal proceedings. Bidder shall submit self-declaration certificate in this regard.	Bidder shall submit self-declaration certificate in this regard.
Bidder who has initiated legal action/litigation against GTL Group (as defined in GCC) or any of the GTL group company, shall not be considered eligible for bidding. Further, Bidders against whom GTL or any of the GTL group company has initiated inquiry/ legal action/ litigation shall not be considered eligible for bidding. Bidder shall submit self-declaration certificate in this regard.	Bidder shall submit self-declaration certificate in this regard.
Bidding Entity Status	Consortium/ Joint venture bids are not acceptable.
The Bidder should not have been put on “Holiday” by Public Sector Project Management Consultant (like EIL, Mecon) or banned/blacklisted or put on Holiday by Government department/public Sector undertaking (including by GTL Group as defined in GCC)on due date of submission of bid. Further, neither Bidder nor their allied agency/(ies) should be on banning list of the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas. In case there is any change in status of the declaration prior to award of contract, the same has to be promptly informed to the Owner by the Bidder in which case also, the owner shall remain entitled to disqualify the bidder and cancel the award without prejudice to any of the rights and remedies of the owner. It shall be the sole responsibility of the Bidder to inform about their status regarding “Holiday/Banned/Blacklisted” on due date of submission of bid and during the course of finalization of the tender. Concealment of the facts shall tantamount to misrepresentation of facts and shall lead to action against such Bidders as per provision of tender. The Bidder shall be required to furnish an undertaking in respect of the above, on Non-Judicial stamp paper of appropriate value, in a format prescribed in tender, as part of its bid submission. Bidder to submit self-declaration on stamp paper of minimum Rs.300/- for above Requirement.	Bidder to submit self-declaration on stamp paper of minimum Rs.300/- for above requirement.

Note:

- a) Bidder to submit all relevant documentary evidence establishing compliance towards aforementioned bid qualification criteria failing which it shall render the bid to be summarily rejected at sole discretion of Owner.
- b) Experience of only the bidding entity shall be considered. Bidder must satisfy the above criteria on their own. Credentials of Third Party/ Parent Company/ Subsidiary Company/ Partner firm etc. shall not be accepted.
- c) In-house work experience (where for the past experience referred for qualification, the Agency/ sub-contractor and the owner belong to the same organization) shall not be considered as valid experience for the purpose of qualification.
- d) Consortium/ Joint venture bids are not acceptable.
